Feedback Analysis on curriculum Design and Development
Action Taken Report 2022-23

College collects feedback from various students and stakeholders for the academic year 2022-23. Further these feedbacks were scrutinized and analysed in the meetings of departments and IQAC. Following remedies and actions were suggested.

In the student feedback, most of the students were found to be satisfied with the current curriculum and its usefulness. However students expressed their grievance about the ways of illustration and inclusion of practical based contents.

All concerned are instructed accordingly to illustrate the content in greater detail and are advised to take more effort so that the student will get new practical based knowledge which they can use in real life situations. All departments are asked to formulate and start a new job and skill oriented certificate courses.


In the teacher feedback, most of the teachers expressed their happiness about curriculum and its flexibility. However teachers came across some difficulties like reference material, skill based contents and employability.


Teachers were instructed to collect and create references for the content to be taught. They were encouraged to participate in syllabus restructuring workshops so that necessary changes are forwarded to the board of studies while framing the syllabus. Further teachers were instructed to start some new job and skill oriented courses which can enhance the employability among students.

Alumni of the college gave their feedback on curriculum design and development. Most of the alumni expressed their satisfaction about expectations about syllabus and marked that the syllabus helps them to develop their personality. However some of the alumni expressed their grievance about skill based contents and employability.

Employer stated that the curriculum which their wards have studied was interesting and it helps to develop its personality. They agree that skill and job based opportunities are included in curriculum.

Faculty members were asked to interact with alumni and collect their aspiration and suggestions about curriculum. Alumni were requested to extend a helping hand for updating the skill based contents and employability.
